**Acupuncture Detoxification Specialist (ADS) Acudetox Training**

Many areas within North America allow medical and addictions professionals to learn and implement the National Acupuncture Detoxification Association's (NADA) 5-needle Acudetox Protocol. Enhance your client services throughout all phases of recovery with this simple, low-cost and widely used technique that has been shown to significantly reduce cravings, physical symptoms, relapse, inpatient admissions, anxiety, insomnia and agitation.

The National Institutes of Health concluded that acupuncture for addictions, "may be useful as an adjunct treatment or an acceptable alternative or be included in a comprehensive management program."

This course covers not only the actual acupuncture techniques and points, but also Chinese Medical and Western Addictions Treatment concepts as well as NADA's program philosophies. Participants will also complete a pre-training reading assignment and several homework assignments.

Completion of the full 70 hours of training (30 didactic/40 clinical) will permit health-care professionals such as counselors, nurses, clinical social workers and outreach workers working in the addictions field to treat their clients with this technique. After successful completion of this two-day seminar, trainees will be able to begin the clinical component. Upon completion of all course requirements, trainees can apply to NADA for a Certificate of Training Completion as an Acupuncture Detoxification Specialist. Several states and provinces have specific regulations for practicing Acudetox. It is the responsibility of the ADS to comply with these provisions.

Continuing Education Credits

Several states and the province of Ontario recognize this course through CECs. Speak to your trainer for further information.
